



#### Land Ownership in Arizona


The State of Arizona contains an estimated 72,931,000 acres, or approximately 113,417 square miles, making it the fifth largest state in the United States. The surface land ownership in Arizona can be classified in four basic categories.


The percentages are estimates derived from digitized map data. The category called Private is overestimated due to the inclusion of small amounts of land owned by local, State, and Federal agencies.






























